ELMO PEARCE LEE, JR.

Elmo Pearce Lee, Jr., one of the children of the marriage of Judge Elmo Pearce Lee, Sr. and Ella Katherine Galloway Lee, was born May 3rd, 1907 at Mississippi City, Mississippi.

Mr. Lee removed to Shreveport, Louisiana with his parents in the year 1930 and continuously resided here until his death on April 25th, 1969.

Mr. Lee was a graduate of Centenary College and received his law degree from Tulane University Law School; and in 1931 he was admitted to the practice of law by the Supreme Court of Louisiana.

Mr. Lee was personally well known, and he was recognized as a well qualified and capable lawyer at the Shreveport, Louisiana Bar. He was also a member of the Louisiana Bar Association and of the American Bar Association. He was an eloquent and persuasive orator at the Bar.

The decedent was a member of the social fraternity, Kappa Sigma, and of the legal fraternity, Phi Delta Phi.

He was a Past Exalted Ruler of the Shreveport Lodge 122 B P O Elks, and at his demise he was a director of the Shreveport Civic Opera Association.
