Grace Williamson attended Louisiana State University and graduated from the Louisiana State University Law School in 1938. After practicing law in South Louisiana she moved to Shreveport where she was active in the practice of law for a number of years. She also served frequently as Acting Judge of the City Court of Shreveport. Following her retirement from active practice in 1974 she served as a Deputy Clerk of the Civil Division of the City Court of Shreveport in the mid 1970's. By appointment of the Louisiana Supreme Court she served as Interim Judge of the City Court of Shreveport in 1980. She died in Napoleonville, Louisiana on April 25, 1986.

Her courtroom demeanor was always exemplary. She always handled her cases diligently and had the ability to handle a large volume of work in an efficient and professional manner.
