## SUPREME COURT OF LOUISIANA

## ORDER

Acting under the authority of Article V, Sections 1 and 5 of Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the ongoing spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Louisiana, Governor John Bel Edwards' declaration of a public health emergency in Proclamation Number 25 JBE 2020, President Donald Trump's declaration of a national emergency on March 13, 2020, Governor John Bel Edwards' extension of emergency provisions announced on April 27, 2020, and the need to amend the Order of this Court dated April 6, 2020,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

All filings which were or are due to this Court between Thursday, March 12, 2020 through Friday, May 15, 2020 shall be considered timely if filed no later than Monday, May 18, 2020. Parties who are unable to meet this deadline due to the COVID-19 emergency may submit motions for extensions of time, supported by appropriate documentation and argument.
