ORDER

Acting under the authority of Article V, Sections 5(A) and 22(B), Constitution of 1974, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering that a vacancy exists in the office of Justice of the Peace, Parish of Caddo, Justice of the Peace Ward Seven, because no one qualified for the Election, and further considering the willingness of Justice of the Peace Glenda Ennis Britton to accept said appointment,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Justice of the Peace Glenda Ennis Britton, Parish of Caddo, Justice of the Peace Ward Six, be and she is hereby appointed as Justice of the Peace pro tempore for the Parish of Caddo, Justice of the Peace Ward Seven, effective June 1, 2025 through August 31, 2025, or until the vacancy is filled, whichever occurs sooner, or until further order of this Court, at which time this appointment shall terminate.

This Order shall not deprive Justice of the Peace Glenda Ennis Britton of her office as justice of the peace for the Parish of Caddo, Justice of the Peace Ward Six, or of any other court to which she may have been assigned by previous order of this Court.
